

Volunteer as a Poll Monitor with ACLU Election Protection

What is Election Protection?

Election Protection is a nonpartisan program that strengthens democracy by safeguarding voter access to the polls. We organize poll monitor volunteers during the election season to ensure all eligible Nevada voters can cast their ballots.

What do volunteers do?

- **Empower Voters.** Answer voter questions, provide support, and ensure that voters are aware of their rights.
- **Monitor Polling Locations.** Monitor the length of lines and wait times at the polls.
- **Protect Voter Access.** Ensure voters can access their right to vote by observing the polling locations.

The Clark County Election Department is looking for election workers who will assist voters at the polls, help with check-ins, and ensure smooth operations at early voting sites and Election Day vote centers. Spanish, Filipino, and Mandarin language skills are desirable. Apply now!

When (Work Dates)

Primary Dates:

- Primary Early Voting - 5/23/26 to 6/5/26
- Primary Election Day - 6/9/26

General Dates:

- General Early Voting - 10/17/26 to 10/30/26
- Election Day - 11/3/26

Pay

- Early Voting: \$17-\$20/hour
- Election Day: \$200-\$250 (flat)
- Training Pay: \$50 for each class

(Training begins 3/2/2026)

Eligibility Requirements:

All election workers must meet all of the requirements below:

- Be a registered voter in Clark County, NV OR enrolled in High School & at least 16 years old
- Not be a candidate or relative of a candidate for nomination or election in 2026
- Not be a poll watcher or observer during the election you are working
- Successfully complete the Election Department's training
