1. Our RSVPS were 1100+ with 2200 minimum attending. ACLU put us at 3000
2. Overwhelming Positive Feedback 99% most common feedback was appreciation and the feeling of solidarity and joy
3. Successful coordination with HPD No serious incidents. Thank you Jen I for coordinating with HPD.
4. Press Exposure was minimal due to the issues in Vegas. However our photos were used in stories. Rachel Maddow gave us a shout out!
5. Met The People's Medic and will make plans to collaborate with them.
6. We are pausing protests to pursue Social Justice and GOTV/ Voter Education

D. Get Out The Vote/Voter Education Committee Calls to Action

- **How Voting in Clark County Is Changing - Presentation by Stephanie C. Voting information: <https://www.clarkcountynv.gov/government/departments/elections/>**

Nevada has changed how we vote in person. Stephanie will discuss what to expect and how to be prepared for this new experience.

There is a 3rd step to voting in person – have to insert your ballot into a tabulator before you leave the voting location.

Check if you're registered to vote. Go to <https://www.clarkcountynv.gov/government/departments/elections/> to double check your registration.

Only Democrats can vote in the Democratic primary. If you're not a registered Dem, you can change your party affiliation at the website, and then change back after the primary if you don't want to remain Dem.

Bring your voter registration card AND your driver's license, just to be sure you have everything you need. Your signature has to match some piece of official identification.

Mail in voting and drop off is still available in NV.

Need Election workers. This is a paid position. Training is provided. Go to <https://www.clarkcountynv.gov/government/departments/elections/> for information and to sign up.

Funding for Henderson Parks & Rec is on the ballot, representing 40% of their budget. If the referendum doesn't pass, we lose that money because it goes directly to Clark County!!! There are 77 parks in Henderson that are well maintained. Please support this referendum.

- **Question 7 vs. SAVE Act - Jen P**

The Question we will vote on is: Should the Nevada Constitution be amended to require voters to either present photo identification to verify their identity when voting in-person or to provide certain personal information to verify their identity when voting by mail ballot?

A handout comparing NV Question 7 and the SAVE Act were distributed and are attached to these minutes.

1. Poll monitors for ACLU of Nevada. Monitors are different than election/poll workers. Monitors only observe. This is not a paid position.

3. Field Team 6 drives will be coordinated at CSN. Thanks to China and Sheila who did a voter drive during No Kings 3.0
