Important to understand where people get their information.

## **GOTV/Voter Education:**

No Chair. Lianne reporting. (We need someone to chair!)

**The SAVE Act**, which passed the House, and is waiting to be voted on in the Senate, will, if passed, disenfranchise 70 million women who don't have a passport or whose name is different than their birth certificate because of marriage, divorce, etc. Kim Keel and Jen Ihrig are focusing on this legislation. For more information, reach out to them on Signal.

**Field Team 6: Lianne.** The plan to launch recently didn't pan out, so there will be a soft launch at the February 15 rally. The mission of Field Team 6 is to register Democrats to vote. If

you are participating, wear a left-leaning tee shirt. There will be stickers to give out to people you talk to, and registration forms they can complete. Lianne delivers completed forms.

**School Board Activism:** Bryan is attending school board meetings to speak out against infringements on 1st and 14th Amendment rights. There is a petition to impeach a Moms of Liberty school board member.

**League of Women Voters:** Jan is our liaison to the LWV. On April 26 there is an event at the Enterprise Library: a Board of Education Candidate Forum. There will be tabling opportunities. LWV is very easy to join. Meetings are on Zoom. There is a coalition forming of non partisan groups to save democracy, ie., NAACP, ACLU, AUW, NOW RWB to allow Independents to vote in state Primaries. First Fridays - get people to sign petitions. 150,000 signatures needed by June 24.

### **Social Activism:**

We will not apply for permits to stage protests. Protesting on public sidewalks is our right. Ignore trolls. Do not engage. Give them the peace sign.

For February 15 protest:

10am - Noon on the corner of Eastern and Horizon Ridge.

150 people are signed up; we expect 300 - 500.

Handmaids of Vegas and music group will be there.

The Handmaids of Las Vegas, a group participating in local events, will be there. They focus on community and solidarity, with activities appearing on Instagram.

March 28 is No Kings 3 at Eastern and Horizon Ridge. Expecting 4000 - 5000 people. No Kings 2 had 3000 people. Numbers are growing.

Everyone got a lanyard today. The back of the lanyard contains a QR code to upload photos from protests. Please upload your photos so we can get them on our socials.

Press statements were sent to media. Media has been showing up to events.

Parking? In the shopping center. If you need a bathroom, please purchase something from that business.

Stephanie will have poster board and markers if you want to make a sign at our next meeting.

### **Social Justice**

### **SCA Democratic Club Update:**
