Alan showed us fake videos made by AI that to the untrained eye look real. He took us through the more well known AI

programs and what they each do well. He advised us not to believe what we see; sad but true. He pointed out some blatant AI telltale signs: more than 5 fingers on hands, more than 2 arms on human beings, etc.

Bella and Jen made the case for getting as many people registered as possible before the SAVE Act is passed (more likely now that the GOP in the Senate reversed its position on the filibuster)

At No Kings 3 on March 28 there will be a GOTV table. Need volunteers.

There is a plan to go to Assisted Living and Nursing Care homes to register voters.

*Notaries Needed: the SAVE Act would required that your mail in ballot be notarized. If anyone is a notary, or knows someone who is, who would be willing to volunteer their services if the act passes, please let them know.

Real ID won't qualify as voter eligibility because only 4 states check citizenship status.

The best ID for voting is a US Passport, but 50% of Americans don't have one, and it's costly and for many to get one, making it a poll tax.

The committee also wants to research judges. Gerri said she'd volunteer to do that.

Again, need volunteers during No Kings 3 for GOTV. After No Kings 3, will focus hard on SAVE.
